Microsoft has confirmed Project Online will be retired on 30 September 2026.

After this date:

- Project Online environments will no longer be accessible
- Project, portfolio and resource data held in Project Online will be lost
- You'll need to move to an alternative PPM platform

This is more than a licensing change. If you rely on Project Online, retirement creates a real risk to project continuity and delivery.

Why delaying increases risk

As end-of-life approaches, organisations that wait face:

- Less time for new system testing, change management and adoption
- Reduced implementation partner availability as migration demand spikes



The transition can be completed in six weeks, but the window to plan and secure migration capacity is closing.
